<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Power Point• Tricky scenarios regarding subject verb agreement.• Work sheets per pupil• Handout per pupil	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The primary focus is awareness of subject verb agreement rules to avoid mistakes.• Connecting previous knowledge of grammar to new content.• Students will demonstrate their understanding of the learned rules by using them in oral and written sentences.			
Warm-up and Objective Discussion				
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask students Have you ever wondered whether to say: News /are/ OR /is/ very shocking. Five miles /are/ OR /is/ not far. Five thousand dollars /are/ OR /is/ a big amount.• Elicit responses• Inform students that they are going to have an overview of confusing possible scenarios regarding subject verb agreement.• Later they will practice it.
